 Lecture Notes in Geoinformation and Cartography and/or in the Journal of
 Location Based Services by Taylor & Francis. If the reviews are not positive,
 we might consider the submission for the following category.
- Work in progress to present ongoing work. Review of the abstract. If accepted, you are invited to give an oral presentation at the symposium and an extended abstract or full paper (your choice) will be published in the online proceedings of the symposium.
- Showcases live presentations of products and developments. Showcase
 presenters can submit an extended abstract or full paper for the online
 proceedings of the symposium, as long as it is scientific. Please contact us
 for individual arrangements.
